

Riders Against Cancer

Rules

All Members must abide by these rules while participating in an official RAC ride or event. All care will be taken to keep riders safe during rides and events, but responsibility falls to the rider.

- 1. Do not overtake the ride leader.
- 2. Treat all other members with respect.
- 3. All Members shall promote the interests and purposes of RAC and shall do nothing to bring RAC into disrepute.
- 4. Where there is a dispute between any members of RAC, this dispute is to be brought to the attention of any committee member, whereby the dispute will be resolved by the committee.

Subscriptions and fees

The Committee may accept or decline an application for membership. The Committee must advise the applicant of its decision (but is not required to provide reasons for that decision).

The annual subscription runs from 1st August to 31st July each year. Any Member failing to pay the annual subscription within 1 calendar month(s) of the date the same was due for payment shall be considered as unfinancial and shall (without being released from the obligation of payment) have no membership rights and shall not be entitled to participate in any Society activity or to access or use the Society's premises, facilities, equipment and other property until all the arrears are paid. If such arrears are not paid within 2 months of the due date for payment of the subscription the Committee may terminate the Member's membership (without being required to give prior notice to that Member).

Ceasing to be a member

A Member ceases to be a Member:

- on death, or
- by resignation from that Member's class of membership by notice to the Secretary, or
- on termination of a Member's membership following a dispute resolution process under these Rules.
